This letter is in response to an inquiry of permittee of Station WCON-FM regarding Special Condition 5 of referenced Construction Permit.

Applicant is wishing to site FM broadcast antenna on the same tower and above the aperture in use by WPPR (FM), which uses Jampro model JMPC-1 R DA directional antenna. The proof-of-performance for this antenna was issued on November 7, 1996 and the certification for that document was signed by myself.

A perusal of our records shows that there was a 3-1/8" transmission line simulated in our full scale model of the antenna and tower used for measuring the directional pattern on our far field range in November, 1996. We were told during preparations for that work that this transmission line was on the face opposite the Northerly leg of the tower. This, apparently, is the same line as is being proposed for use by WCON-FM, according to applicant's broadcast consultant.

On that basis, we believe that the referenced transmission line has already been included in the reported measured pattern of WPPR, and that further use of this line is warranted if its location has not been changed.
