TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Bangor Baptist Church ("BBC"), permittee of FM translator station W263AS, Channel 263D, Vassalboro, Maine. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Attached, as Exhibit A, is a calculation of the transmitter power output power for the W263AS translator.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W263AS permit. The first condition relates to radio frequency radiation limits at the site. BBC herein restates that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W263AS or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

The second condition notes that an application for station license must be on file before commencing program test with the facilities authorized in the permit. BBC acknowledges this condition and notes that it will not commence program test until FCC Form 350 is filed with the Commission.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that all conditions on the W263AS permit have been satisfied.
