On May 26, 2010, the Federal Communications Commission issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture¹ to Media General Communications Holdings, LLC, licensee of Station WHLT(TV), for failure to comply with the limits on commercial matter in children's programming.² This letter is to inform you that the Video Division does not plan to take further action relating to this matter and considers this proceeding closed. You should not construe the closing of the proceeding as a determination that a violation did not occur. The Video Division will not hesitate to take action against the Licensee for violations, including those of a similar nature, that occur in the future.
