Dear Mr. Nelson:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 4, 2015. NMI requests further extension of the STA granted on March 4, 2002, to operate Station WSPY with temporary facilities due to loss of the licensed site.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, NMI states that in the past six month STA period it has taken additional steps in order to allow for the filing of an acceptable FCC Form 301 minor change application for a new transmitter site.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WSPY may continue to operate with the following facilities:


<sup>1</sup> WSPY is licensed to Geneva, Illinois, for DA operation on 1480 kHz with 1 kW day and 0.5 kW night.

Geographic Coordinates: 41° 51' 11" NL, 88° 19' 38" WL (NAD 1927)  
Frequency: 1480 kHz  
Operating hours: Unlimited  
Operating power: 0.125 kW  
Antenna: Long wire

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. NMI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. We recommend that NMI file an acceptable FCC Form 301 application before the expiration date shown below in order to show that substantial progress has been made.

This authority expires on **March 21, 2016.**
