**Exhibit 24****Description: REASONS FOR STA**

As the Commission is aware, on September 20, 2017, WVJP-FM lost part of its antenna and tower during Hurricane Maria. A silent STA was filed with the FCC and authorized, and, since that time, the Commission has been told that the station has restored service and the station has been operating with reduced power pursuant to special temporary authority by using two bays of its licensed antenna and an auxiliary transmitter. As of now, the licensee has advised that the station is in the reconstruction process and will need FCC authorization for modified facilities before full- power operation can resume. Although the Commission is aware that the station's most recent STA extension expired at the end of last month, because of record-keeping relocation issues this request for an extension was inadvertently not submitted until this time. However, in order for the station to continue to provide a minimum of service to the public while its full-powered facilities continue to be rebuilt, it is hereby requested that the Commission grant the station special temporary authority for its operation pursuant to the authority granted under file number BSTA-20171130ABN, subject to the terms and conditions specified in its original STA.

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
