Notification of Reduced Power Operation and Request for Special Temporary Authorization

NCE Station KNWP(FM), Port Angeles, WA (Facility ID 81161)

Pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the FCC's Rules, Washington State University (the "University"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio Station KNWP(FM), Port Angeles, Washington, notifies the FCC of the temporary reduced power operation of KNWP due to equipment problems, and respectfully requests Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") to maintain the reduced power status for a period of four (4) months.

Station KNWP has been operating at approximately 16% of its authorized power level since January 16, 2015 due to equipment damage. Specifically, the station's transmitter power amplifiers blew out, necessitating the current reduced power status and a temporary suspension of HD operation. The University is presently working towards restoration of full power service, and has returned the transmitter to the manufacturer for repair. While it awaits repair and return of the transmitter, the University has been operating KNWP with a lower power replacement. As a result, the University now seeks reduced power STA in order to maintain the current reduced power operation for more than 30 days.

A grant of reduced power STA will serve the public interest by allowing the University to maintain the station's current noncommercial educational radio operation and programming for listeners in the station's local community while it continues to pursue the repairs needed to restore full power service. The University is a noncommercial educational licensee and it operates KNWP on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the University qualifies as a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements, pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
