Request for Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. O'Connor:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 11, 2019, on behalf of Educational Media Foundation (EMF), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Booster Station KYRA-FM1 to remain silent.

EMF's request states that Station KYRA-FM1 went silent on November 9, 2018, for technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

EMF's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KYRA-FM1 to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KYRA-FM1 will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., November 10, 2019.**²

EMF is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If EMF does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.³

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.⁴

Finally, Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules permits licensees to temporarily discontinue operations for good cause, and for a period not to exceed 30 days without further authority.⁵ This rule requires that the licensee notify the Commission by letter not later than the 10th day of limited or discontinued operations, and requires a licensee to seek Commission authorization for any period of

limited or discontinued operations exceeding 30 days. EMF failed to submit a timely request for an STA to permit Station KYRA-FM1 to remain silent beyond December 9, 2018, and the action taken herein shall not be construed as authorizing the station to remain silent between December 9, 2018, and February 11, 2019.
