Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed September 19, 2006, on behalf of Winton Road Broadcasting Co. LLC ("WRB"). WRB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on July 17, 2006, to operate Station KRTZ with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, WRB states that delivery and installation of a replacement antenna has been delayed by the manufacturer.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KRTZ may continue to operate with reduced power. WRB must notify the Commission when licensed

operation is restored. WRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 30, 2007**.
