

MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP COMPLIANCE STUDY All New York

This Multiple Ownership Compliance Study was conducted to determine if five stations (all FM) could be co-owned and comply with §73.3555 of the Commission's Rules. The city grade contours of co-owned WCSO (FM), Southampton, New York, WBAZ (FM), Bridgehampton, New York, WBEA (FM), Southold, New York, WEHM (FM), East Hampton, New York and WMOS (FM), Montauk, New York were overlaid on a contour map (Exhibit #1). WMOS (FM) is in a different market than the other four co-owned stations so it is not included as a Subject Station in this study.


WCSO holds Construction Permit BPH-19920928MM as well as Pending Application BMPH-20010905AAJ. Exhibit #1 indicates the 70 dBu contour of both WCSO Sites. Although this study specifically addresses the WCSO Application site, the CP site multiple ownership has an identical analysis. The Subject Stations are shown in Exhibit #2.

We overlaid the contours of the Subject Stations on contour maps showing all AM and FM services to the Subject Area. This is shown in Exhibit #3. Exhibit #4 is a tabulation of all services to the Subject Area.

The market is comprised of 20 stations including the four Subject Stations (all FM). The Commission's multiple ownership rule in §73.3555 (a) (1) (iii) states:

“in a radio market with between 15 and 29 (inclusive) commercial radio stations, a party may own, operate, or control up to 6 commercial radio stations, not more than 4 of which are in the same service (AM or FM);”

Therefore, it is believed that the ownership of the Subject Stations is in compliance with §73.3555 of the Commission's Rules.
