Request For Extension of  
Special Temporary  
Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Laudadio:

This letter concerns your request, filed on November 24, 2010, on behalf of Horizon Christian Fellowship ("Horizon"), for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit FM Translator Station K242AZ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that K242AZ went silent on May 13, 2010, for financial reasons. On May 25, 2010, Horizon requested an STA for the station to remain silent for financial reasons. The STA was granted on May 26, 2010, and expired on November 24, 2010. Horizon's current request states that inadequate financial resources still exist. Accordingly, Horizon requests that the STA be extended. Horizon's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Horizon's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K242AZ to remain silent until May 13, 2011.

**Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for K242AZ (FX) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. on May 14, 2011.<sup>1</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).**

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
