Dear Mr. Wilkinson:

This is written on behalf of KVMD Licensee Co., L.L.C., ("KVMD"), the licensee of Station KVMD-DT, Digital Channel 23, Twentynine Palms, California.

You have advised KVMD that KJLA, LLC's ("KJLA"), the licensee of Low Power Television Station KSMV-LP, Channel 33, Los Angeles, California, has heretofore filed with the FCC a displacement application (File No. BDISDTL-20081022ABW) (the "Application") seeking to change its digital output channel to Channel 23.

In connection with the application that KJLA has filed, KVMD was made aware by you that the operation of the digital operations of KSMV-LP station on Channel 23, from its transmitter site on Mt. Wilson, is predicted to cause interference to the proposed operations of KVMD-DT in excess of the threshold permitted by the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). KVMD has reviewed this matter with its engineering consultant and is aware of the locations where it will occur and the level interference that KVMD-DT is expected to receive.

After due consideration, KVMD wishes to confirm that it has no objection to the request KJLA proposes to submit to the FCC for modification of KSMV-LP to change its output channel to Channel 23 as proposed in the Application.

KJLA is authorized to submit this letter to the FCC in support of the Form 346 application that it has submitted.


