

Exhibit 10 - - Compliance With Broadcast Auction Rules

The applicant, KM Communications, Inc. (“KM”), prior to the FM construction permit auction, Auction No. 70 (the “Auction”), was not, and currently is not, a party to any partnerships, joint ventures, consortia or other agreements, arrangements or understandings of any kind, written or oral, related to the Auction competitive bidding process or to the licenses being auctioned, including any agreements relating to the post-auction market structure, nor any explicit or implicit agreements or understandings of any kind regarding bid amounts, bidding strategies, or the particular licenses on which KM would or would not bid. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2107(d).

KM is an Illinois corporation, and the address for its headquarters and principal place of business is 3654 West Jarvis Avenue, Skokie, Illinois 60076. Myoung Hwa Bae (“Mrs. Bae”) is President, Treasurer, the sole Director and the sole shareholder holding 100% of the shares of voting common stock in KM, and her stepson, Kevin Joel Bae (“Kevin Bae”), is Vice President and Secretary of KM; they are the only “controlling interests” for KM. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2112(a). Mrs. Bae resides at 19 Rolling Ridge Road, Northfield, IL 60093, and Kevin Bae resides at 1113 Pfingsten Road, Glenview, IL 60025; both Mrs. Bae and Kevin Bae are citizens of the United States. Id. KM is an Illinois corporation, and therefore is a corporate citizen of the United States. Id.

KM holds FCC licenses or construction permits, and its controlling interest holders Mrs. Bae and Kevin Bae hold or have interests in the FCC licenses or construction permits held by KM or the other FCC-regulated entities in which they hold controlling and attributable interests, which hold FCC licenses or construction permits for the commercial full power television, Class A television, Low Power Television (“LPTV”), and AM and FM broadcast stations, as are described in Exhibit 3 to this application (i.e., other mass media interests). See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2112(a)(6). KM and other entities listed in Exhibit 3 are also applicants for construction permits for additional commercial television, LPTV, AM and FM, and FM translator broadcast stations, and for lower 700 MHz band licenses (a complete list would be submitted upon request).

Although the status did not confer any bidding credits or other benefit to KM in this Auction, KM noted on its Form 175 short-form auction application that it qualifies as a woman-owned and minority-owned business. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2110(i)-(j). Mrs. Bae is female, and both Mrs. Bae and Kevin Bae are of Asian American extraction. See § 1.2110(j). Therefore, KM is 100% both women-owned and minority-owned, as defined by Section 1.2110(c) of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.2110(c). There are no agreements that may affect KM's designated entity status, including no partnership agreements, shareholder agreements, management agreements and other agreements, including oral agreements, establishing, as applicable, de facto or de jure control of KM. See § 1.2110(j).

KM did not claim designated entity status as a small business, and therefore is not required to submit the information required by Section 1.2112(b). See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2112(b).
