

## **Exhibit 2**

Concho Christmas Celebration, Inc., is organized as a Section 501(c)(4) non-profit corporation and is therefore eligible to file an application for a Low Power FM Station at San Angelo, Texas. The applicant is a local organization, having been incorporated in Texas with a San Angelo address on March 13, 1998. Its purpose in establishing the proposed non-commercial low power educational facility is to provide an educational alternative to the commercial programming currently available in the San Angelo area. The proposed station will broadcast community related, educational, news and public affairs, and instructional programming related to current issues and problems in San Angelo (such as education, drug abuse, unemployment and tourism) as well as devotional, religious, music, children's and other programming of a nature designed to serve the needs and be of interest to the residents of San Angelo. The applicant will serve those interests and needs through the broadcast presentation of high quality programs designed to be informational, cultural and educational. The applicant will seek to enhance community spirit and, by so doing, will contribute to the enhancement of quality of life in San Angelo. San Angelo presently lacks a community oriented station and the applicant intends to fill that void. The station will serve as a vital communication link for all residents of San Angelo.

While the applicant has not yet determined its final program schedule, it intends to broadcast the following programming. First, it will broadcast arts educational programming in conjunction with the city Cultural Affairs Council. This programming will center around arts and music education and appreciation. The station will work with city officials to provide programming to educate the community regarding items dealing with such matters as fire safety,

police safety and other government programs and services. The station will work with Angelo State University by making its broadcast facilities available to students as part of a learning program. The station also intends to cover events centering around the University and hopes to provide instructional programming in concert with the University. The station will also be airing local weather alerts on a regular basis because of the violent weather conditions which often occur in and around San Angelo. The station will also be airing programming providing information on current events occurring in San Angelo.

In a typical broadcast day we would expect to commence broadcasting at 6:00 a.m. with news, weather and music. Programming would continue until 7:00 p. m. and will be highlighted by the programming discussed above - - arts education programming, programming dealing with city services, events occurring in San Angelo and instructional programming.
