

OTHER AUTHORIZATIONS

Following consummation of the *pro forma* assignment for which Commission approval is sought, WEEK-TV License, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession, the licensee of WEEK-TV, will be an indirect subsidiary of Granite Broadcasting Corporation, Debtor-in-Possession (“Granite”).¹ Granite also is the ultimate parent of the following television stations and their associated broadcast auxiliary facilities:
