

**DOCUMENTATION SHOWING COMPLIANCE
WITH SPECIAL OPERATING CONDITIONS FOR KXPT AND KOMP
BACKUP TRANSMITTERS AT BLACK MT. ARDEN SITE.**

Both the KOMP and KXPT backup transmitters are located at the BLM Black Mt. Arden site located in township 23, south, Range 62 East6, Mount Diablo Meridian (MDM) Nevada section 15 and 16. Geographic coordinates are 35—56-44 North by 115-02-31 West. The site is accessed via a locked gate restricted road starting with the first gate at 3.3 miles from the site. This gate is clearly marked with an RF electromagnetic field hazard danger sign.

There are four additional gates between this one and the actual site. Two, over the spillway are rarely closed. At a point about 1 mile from the site, an additional locked gate blocks any vehicular traffic including prevention of two wheel vehicles bypassing that gate. That gate is also marked with RF electromagnetic field hazard danger signs.

At the entrance to the site and surrounding the site is a chain link fence, topped with barbed wire and clearly marked with RF electromagnetic field hazard danger signs. The entrance is via a locked, clearly marked gate.



Within the site measurements have been made to determine dangerous levels and markings are clearly posted.

Combination and Key locks, difficult terrain, Chain link fencing with barbed wire topping and poor road conditions keep the general public from access to the site. All areas are clearly marked with warning signs in accordance with FCC and OSHA requirements. Approximately 2 miles below the site there is a public hiking trail, that does not ever come closer than two miles from the site.
