Digital Flash Cut Application. The within application is filed as a digital flash cut of a licensed facility. Also sought is a change of location to a taller tower, change of antenna pattern and of ERP. The 51 dBu F50,90 DTV service contour of the within proposal fully encompasses the licensed transmitter location and NTSC F50,50 74 dBu contour of the underlying license.

Interference Study. An OET 69 Longley-Rice study has been performed for the above-captioned application. The study was performed on a Sun Blade computer running the official FCC Longley-Rice program *tv_process_dlptv* as provided by Techware, Inc and shows compliance with all appropriate ruleparts including §74.793.

Coordination of channel 64. The within application seeks a permit to construct a facility on channel 64. This is the same facility that has been operating on channel 64 throughout its history. The within application seeks to position it favorably with respect to a subsequent displacement filing on a channel within the core. As timing is critical in connection with seeking channels which will be relinquished as part of the full service transition, it is desired to keep this facility permitted on channel 64 at the present time with the intent of moving into the core prior to the need for use of frequencies in the 700 MHz spectrum by future licensee users. To that end, coordination and notification has been performed in accordance with §74.786(e) with the following:
