Calvary Chapel (church) of Menomonie is a non-stock, non-profit organization which was incorporated under the laws of the State of Wisconsin on December 21st, 1990.

Calvary Chapel (church) of Menomonie is an educational and religious organization, that educates our community through teaching of the Bible as a tool to successful living in both society at large, as well as personal and family life. As social problems in our world and community are exerting pressures upon individuals of every age, we, through the principles of Biblical teaching, are attempting to teach a lifestyle of Christian foundations and values. We believe that such a lifestyle, has inherently in it, the keys to personal and mental health, as well as the principles to live a full and abundant life. Our community is educated in these principles and values, through the following methods and activities:

Extensive pre-marriage and post-marriage counseling. This counseling is conducted in group classes, as well as couple counseling.

We serve as the chaplaincy program for our county jail. This involves twice weekly group Biblical education meetings, 24-hour availability for one-on-one counseling, extensive higher Biblical education self-study courses through Emmaus Bible college, and evening video presentations following with discussion groups, targeting specific areas of a healthy law abiding life.

Drug, alcohol, and other addiction counseling, through our "Most Excellent Way" addiction program. This is an alternative "12 Step" type program, focusing on education of Biblical principles of overcoming controlling influences in our lives. This program is held weekly, both inside the county correctional facility, as well as on our premises, and is operated as both group and individual counseling.

Our School of Ministry and Discipleship, operates year round as an intensive educational tool, in the training of individuals for the pastorate, missions, as well as service in and to the community. These classes are conducted on a college level, and teach the Bible in depth, with all of its past and current applications. Course work delves into Hebrew and Greek, as well as historical and archeological aspects of scripture. Topics range from specific Bible passages, to leadership methods and applications. The School hosts speakers for twice yearly intensive educational retreats open to everyone to attend.

We conduct "New Believer" classes, which highlight Bible basics and their personal life applications.

We provide free individual counseling to the community, and to Stout University students. This is done through a specific network of staff, in order to gear to needs of the individual. Pastoral counseling, peer counseling, a family counseling are given without charge.

We provide free educational resources through a lending library that is open to the community. This lending library provides video, audio, as well as text based material, covering a wide variety of interpersonal issues. Examples of these are family relations, marriage preparation, child-rearing, addiction treatment, cult and occult information, financial management, as well as extensive Biblical study material.

We operate a recognized campus organization at the University of Wisconsin Stout, which is 2 blocks from our church, and the proposed radio station location. This organization, *Street Level Ministries*, serves as an educational and fellowship-based ministry on campus. Street Level conducts weekly Bible classes in the student center, and regularly provides free speakers for both classroom and campus wide presentations. Speakers are both national and local, and speak on such topics as Biblical archeological evidences, creationism vs. evolution, and homosexual issues. University professors have availed themselves to this free resource, and have opened their classrooms to these speakers and their presentations.

Through *Street Level Ministries*, we publish a free quarterly magazine geared toward the university, and youth/young adult issues. "*Word on the Street*" magazine covers issues such as overcoming drug use, current event news, social problems, Biblical ideals and lifestyle, as well as information concerning availability of counseling, speakers, pregnancy assistance and peer fellowship.

We provide a free food shelf for those in need, and provide recipes for those who receive these free groceries, to assist in maintaining a household food budget.

We provide Spanish language classes to those who want to be part in the ministry and assistance to Spanish speaking individuals, both locally and internationally.

We provide bi-lingual Bibles and Biblical information to foreign exchange students on the campus of the university.

Our objective in establishing a radio station, would be to compliment and further these existing ministries, as well as place us in the position to begin and maintain new ministries in our community. We are the recognized "Street-based" ministry in Menomonie, and are seen in the community as the church that is "reaching out." With the use of a radio station, we would be better able to inform the community and the university of these educational resources, as well as using the station itself as a vehicle to minister to the social and educational needs of our area. Plans for the station include live services, concerts, Bible studies and speaker events for those who cannot attend in person. This is important, as the university is known for its strong program in the area of education on the assistance and training of the handicapped. Because of this we have many individuals in the community who are not as mobile as others, and are not always able to attend live events. Programming plans include ministry and education to specific groups already under our ministry umbrella. These include county jail inmates, university students, and those seeking broader Biblical understanding presented in "real-life" application. Yet, we hope to have a greater reach and appeal, being able to communicate with the whole of the community, Christian or not. With this radio station, we believe we can further teach and assist Menomonie, Wisconsin, in the benefits of a Godly life, and its effects upon every aspect of their lives.
