

***NATURE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE OF
VSS CATHOLIC COMMUNICATIONS, INC.***

VSS Catholic Communications, Inc. (“VSS”) is a not-for-profit corporation organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Nebraska. VSS previously demonstrated its non-commercial educational nature when it acquired Station KVSS(FM) [formerly KBZR], Papillion, Nebraska in 1009 (*see* BALED-20090623AAQ). Its Articles, which are on file with the FCC, expressly provide that the corporation was formed for the purpose of operating and administering a radio station affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church in the United States. The goal of VSS is to create an educational program focusing on the ethical, moral and religious beliefs of the Catholic Church. There are no provisions in its Articles or Bylaws that would restrict VSS from advancing an educational program in full compliance with all FCC policies and the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

VSS seeks to provide instruction, educational guidance and teachings in the areas of morals, scripture, worship, community life and involvement, individual responsibility and other aspects of the Roman Catholic faith. Among the other goals set forth in the Bylaws of the company are the following:

1. The operation of one or more radio stations to broadcast Catholic religious and educational programs aimed at fostering a renewal of the Catholic faith.
2. The distribution of religious and educational material that may be available and furnished by the Catholic church and various religious organizations that are part of the Catholic church.
3. The broadcast of news of local, national and international nature covering events that are of interest to all Catholics.
4. To provide broadcast service free of charge to the local Catholic diocese in which the broadcast is received from individual parishes for airing general public service announcements within each radio station’s broadcast area.

The educational guidance and instructions of the Catholic faith will be directly beneficial to people of all religious traditions as well as those who hold no particular religious belief. On ethical, moral and social issues, the teachings of the Catholic church have great effect on human history, from community or government society responsibility to individual behavior. The proposed station will also include information on the charitable activities of not-for-profit organizations within greater Papillion, Nebraska and surrounding area.
