Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed November 18, 2010, on behalf of Four R Broadcasting, Inc. ("FRB"). FRB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on August 18, 2010, to operate Station KDCD with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, FRB states that it has replaced the station's damaged transmission line; however, the transmitter is still unable to produce full, licensed power. FRB requests extension of STA in order to allow time to complete repairs.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KDCD may

continue to operate with reduced power. FRB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. FRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 5, 2011**.
