Dear Mr. Kinney:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 31, 2019. HMG requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 7, 2016, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application (to change from DA to ND).¹ In support of the request, HMG states that it plans to file the application (followed by an FCC Form 302 application after the construction permit has been granted) in order to resolve all problems caused by the installation of power lines back in 2016.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and HMG may continue to operate with parameters at variance and reduced power to maintain all monitor points within licensed limits. HMG must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from

exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 18, 2020**.
