Subject: Situation of KTGM-TV-DT , Tamuning, Guam

KTGM-TV, TAMUNING, GUAM WAS GRANTED AUTHORITY TO CEASE ANALOG OPERATION AT MIDNIGHT, FEBRUARY 17, 2009 AND THE STATION'S CONSTRUCTION PERMIT REQUIRED THAT THE STATION 'FLASH-CUT' ON CHANNEL 14. HOWEVER, DUE TO THE FOLLOWING TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES, THE LICENSEE COULD NOT SUCCESSFULLY TRANSITION TO ITS DIGITAL OPERATION:

1. THE STATION HAD AN AIR DEHYDRATOR MOTOR FAILURE DURING TESTING OF THE NEW TRANSMITTER AND ANTENNA. THE LICENSEE WAS UNABLE TO REPAIR THE MOTOR AND HAD TO ORDER A NEW ONE FROM THE CONTINENTAL US. THEY ARE CURRENTLY AWAITING AVAILABILITY AND SHIPPING TIME INFORMATION.

2. THE STATION IS HAVING SD FEED PROBLEMS FROM IT STATESIDE, NETWORK SIGNAL PROVIDER. THE SD SIGNAL THAT THE STATION IS RECEIVING IS FULL OF ERRORS . THE LICENSEE IS WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE SIGNAL PROVIDER TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM.

THE LICENSEE BELIEVES IT WILL RESOLVE BOTH PROBLEMS by February 27 and if it fails to do so will notify the Commission pursuant to the rules.
