Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to station K38GL, Lawton, Oklahoma. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that K38GL has been silent since February 2, 2010.² Accordingly, the license for K38GL IS HEREBY CANCELLED, the call sign IS DELETED, and the construction permit to flash-cut to digital operation (File No. BDFCDTL-20090818ABW) IS CANCELLED.
