Dear Ms. Kreisman:

On behalf of Corridor Television, L.L.P. ("Corridor"), licensee of KCWX-DT, Fredericksburg, Texas (the "Station"), and pursuant to Sections 74.102 and 74.131 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 74.102, 74.131, we hereby request an experimental broadcast station authorization, to the extent necessary, for the Station to operate at 45 kW ERP. As described in greater detail in the application for Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") filed concurrently herewith (amending and superseding the STA request previously filed with the Commission on July 13, 2009, FCC File No. BLDSTA-20090713ACR), the Station believes that the 45 kW operation would enable the Station to better serve the many viewers who are currently unable to receive the Station's DTV signal on VHF Channel 5 due to the poor propagation of DTV signals on the lower VHF channels.

An experimental authorization would enable the Station to test this hypothesis through a program that indicates a reasonable promise of substantial contribution to the development of broadcasting. Upon receipt of the authorization, the Station will proceed immediately to implement the program. The transmission of signals by radio is essential to the proposed program, which will be conducted by qualified personnel.

The undersigned is authorized to certify, and does hereby certify, on behalf of Corridor, that neither Corridor nor any party to the application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
