**RE: WQXI(AM) / Richland Tower**

Gentlemen:

This letter is presented to set forth the history of the recent tall tower construction near, and the interaction with, the WQXI(AM) antenna.

In the recent past a tower for Fox Broadcasting was constructed, at which time measurements were made both before and after construction and which revealed no substantial impact on the WQXI(AM) antenna. Richland Towers then constructed a similar tower in the same general area as the Fox tower. The Fox "after" measurement data was obtained and was checked at several locations and, by agreement among the parties, was used for the Richland "before" measurements. The Richland tower was built to full height, the triangular "candelabra" platform was added and one of three top mounted antenna pylons was installed. This completed construction to within a few feet of full authorized height. Measurements were repeated at the same locations as before and these after construction measurements showed by comparison that again, the tall tower construction had no significant impact on the WQXI(AM) antenna.


Subsequent to the original tower construction, the second of three antenna pylons was added to the candelabra platform. Engineers at WQXI(AM) monitored the AM antenna operation during installation of that antenna. Again no effect was seen at the WQXI(AM) antenna.

Considering this chain of events, the extensive monitoring and the lack of any impact on WQXI(AM) from the nearby tower construction, it is the opinion of the undersigned and the countersigning parties to this letter concur that:

- A) The conditions for Before and After measurements required for the lead FCC licensed user of the Richland tower have been met and that there has been no significant impact on WQXI(AM) and no remedial action was needed.
- B) Subsequent additions to the Richland tower, such as antenna pylons, transmission lines and etc., which do not significantly extend the height of the tower, have been demonstrated to also not impact WQXI(AM) and in the future such additions are unlikely to impact WQXI(AM).
- C) Considering the above evidence, such future additions will be considered to, "...not adversely affect the AM station..." as is the goal of Section 73.1692 of the FCC Rules. If FCC permits for future operations contain conditions for compliance with Section 73.1692 of the Rules specific to WQXI(AM), evidence of the above mentioned before and after measurements and lack of impact on WQXI(AM) will be used to have the FCC condition removed from the permits and/or as evidence that any condition which remains is satisfied.

The undersigned parties, being aware of with this condition of no impact from the Richland tower on WQXI(AM), signify their agreement to this understanding by their signatures below.


