

**Applicant Information:**

The applicant is Washington State University (WSU), a comprehensive land-grant university located in Pullman 76 miles by road south of Spokane and 288 miles east of Seattle. It has offices in every county of the state, including branch campuses in Richland, Spokane and Vancouver. WSU is a state agency of the State of Washington.

WSU has been involved in educational telecommunications since 1908 and began broadcasting in 1922. Its Educational Telecommunications and Technology (ETT) unit operates Northwest Public Radio (NWPR), Northwest Public Television (NWPTV) and the Washington Higher Education Telecommunication System (WHETS).
