### Basis for Extension

As previously reported to the Commission, station KBOB(AM) has been operating, day and night, with its nighttime antenna pattern due to an antenna-switching issue (*see* FCC File Nos. BSTA-20220504AAF, BESTA-20221026AAD). Townsquare installed a new RF contactor but after doing so discovered that additional components need to be replaced. Those components were promptly ordered but shipment was delayed by supply chain issues. Since the components were delivered, Townsquare has struggled to schedule a contractor to handle the installation. In the interim, Townsquare respectfully requests an extension of the current STA. Townsquare will promptly notify the Commission when the station is able to resume licensed operations.
