Description of Transaction

This application seeks *nunc pro tunc* Commission consent to a *pro forma* reorganization (the “Reorganization”) of ION Television License, LLC (the “Licensee”), licensee of television station WPXQ-TV, Block Island, Rhode Island (Facility ID 50063).

On May 16, 2018, the control of the Licensee was transferred from ION Media of Providence, Inc. (“ION Providence”) to ION Media Television, Inc. (“IMTV”). ION Providence, a wholly owned subsidiary of IMTV, was merged with and into IMTV pursuant to Florida Articles of Merger filed in accordance with the Florida Business Corporation Act, pursuant to sections 607.1101, 607.1104 and 607.1105, Florida Statutes. Following such time, the separate corporate existence of ION Providence ceased, and IMTV continues as the surviving corporation, and sole member of the Licensee.

The proposed transactions have been undertaken solely for internal reorganization purposes and involve no change in the ultimate ownership or control of the Licensee. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 73.3540(f)(4) of the Commission’s rules, the proposed transaction meets the requirements for the use of *pro forma* procedures on FCC Form 316. The Reorganization will involve various organizational, governance and transfer documents necessary to effectuate the Reorganization, as described above. These agreements, which will comply with the Commission’s rules and policies, will be filed with the Commission upon execution to the extent required by Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules.

In addition, substantively identical applications on FCC Form 316 are filed seeking consent to the *pro forma* transfer of control of the licensees of television stations WBPX-TV, Boston, Massachusetts (Facility ID 7692); WDPX-TV, Woburn, Massachusetts (Facility ID 6476); WPXG-TV, Concord, New Hampshire (Facility ID 48406); and KPPX-TV, Tolleson, Arizona, to IMTV. The applicants respectfully request that the applications be processed and approved concurrently.
