

Question 4 - Other Broadcast Stations of Parties to the Application

Mojave Broadcasting Company, the permittee for KMCC (TV) Channel 34, and KMCC-DT Channel 32, Laughlin, Nevada, has as its officers, directors and shareholders the following: Suzanne E. Rogers is president, secretary, treasurer, a director and a 48% shareholder (as co-trustee of the Plant and Rogers Family Trust dated May 25, 2001); Brian J. Plant is executive vice president, and a director (and holds a community property interest in Ms. Rogers' shares); Perry C. Rogers is vice president, a director, and a 28% shareholder; Kimberly R. Cell is a 24% shareholder.

Suzanne E. Rogers (as co-trustee of the Plant and Rogers Family Trust dated May 25, 2001, and as community property with Brian Plant), Perry C. Rogers and Kimberly R. Cell each own one-third of Meridian Communications of Idaho, Inc. ("MCID"), the permittee of commercial broadcast television Channel 20, Idaho Falls, Idaho, Facility ID 41238, Call Sign 950306KF. Suzanne E. Rogers is a director, the president, secretary and treasurer of MCID. Brian J. Plant is a director and the executive vice president of MCID. Perry C. Rogers is a director and a vice president of MCID. (On August 21, 2003, The Post Company filed a Petition for Reconsideration of the July 22, 2003 grant of the Channel 20 construction permit and the letter of same date from Barbara A. Kreisman, Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau, to J. Dominic Monahan, Esq., wherein the Commission denied the Post's May 15, 1995 Petition to Deny the Channel 20 application. MCID filed its Opposition to the Petition for Reconsideration on September 4, 2003. Post filed its Reply on September 15, 2003.)

Suzanne E. Rogers (as co-trustee of the Plant and Rogers Family Trust dated May 25, 2001, and as community property with Brian Plant), Perry C. Rogers and Kimberly R. Cell each own one-third of Meridian Communications of Montana, Inc., which owns 49% of the issued and outstanding shares (a minority, non-attributable interest) of Rocky Mountain Broadcasting Company ("RMBC"), licensee of commercial broadcast television Channel 10, Helena, Montana, Facility ID 68717. Suzanne E. Rogers is a director and the vice president-operations of RMBC, and Brian J. Plant is the assistant vice president-operations of RMBC.
