Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Snyder:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 19, 2013, on behalf of WTL Communications, Inc. ("WTL"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit Low-Power FM Radio Station KJCR-LP to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that WTL stated that Station KJCR-LP went silent on June 26, 2012, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on August 23, 2012, and expired on February 19, 2013. WTL requests extension of its STA due to continued technical problems. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

WTL's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KJCR-LP to remain silent until June 26, 2013. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KJCR-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., June 27, 2013.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
