CHARTER

OF

ALTON PARK DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The undersigned, desiring to form a charitable corporation under the Tennessee Non-profit Corporation Act, does hereby make and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be Alton Park Development Corporation (hereinafter, the "Corporation").

SECOND: The place in the state of Tennessee where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is 100 E. 37th Street, Chattanooga, Tennessee 37410.

THIRD: The complete address of the Corporation's initial registered office in the State of Tennessee is 100 E. 37th Street, Chattanooga, Tennessee 37410, in the county of Hamilton. The name of the initial registered agent to be located at this address is George Ricks.

FOURTH: The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

FIFTH: The Corporation is a public benefit corporation.

SIXTH: The Corporation shall not have members.

SEVENTH: Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for the charitable or educational purposes to serve low and moderate income people's need for community development and self help as contemplated by Tennessee Code Annotated §13-14-202, including for such purposes, but without limitation thereon:

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SECRETARY OF STATE

1. To combat community deterioration, poverty, racial discrimination and prejudice; to reduce neighborhood tensions; to relieve the poor, distressed, and underprivileged of the Alton Park area of the City of Chattanooga

2. To combat community deterioration by assisting in the maintenance or development in adequate housing in the Alton Park are of Chattanooga.

3. To conduct activities to achieve educational and charitable objectives within the Alton Park are of the City of Chattanooga, including: residential rehabilitation and commercial area revitalization development of health, social services and recreational facilities; and provide other social services and counseling.

4. To raise the economic and educational levels of underprivileged residents in the Alton Park area of the City of Chattanooga by:

a) expanding the opportunities available to said residents to own, manage, and operate business enterprises; furthering the development of locally-owned or operated business enterprises in such area; assisting said residents in developing entrepreneurial and management skills necessary for the successful operation of business enterprises; providing financial support for the successful operation of business enterprises by said residents and assisting said residents in obtaining such financial support form other sources;

b) furnishing management, administrative and other business

advice, support, training, and technical assistance to said

residents to enable them to develop the necessary skills to

operate business ventures successfully.

c) To support or conduct such other or further activities as may

be desirable to lessen the burdens of government.

Solely for the above purposes, the Corporation is empowered to exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the state of Tennessee upon non-profit corporations, including but without limitation thereon, the right and power to receive gifts, bequests, and contributions in any form, to collect dues and to use, apply, invest, and reinvest the principal and/or income therefrom or to distribute the same for the above purposes.

EIGHTH: The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall include not less than three (3) nor more than fifteen (15) persons chosen in accordance with the provisions of the By-laws of the Corporation.

NINTH: No part of the net income of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its incorporators, directors, officers or private individuals, but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article SEVENTH hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the

publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

TENTH: Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ELEVENTH: All references in these Articles of Incorporation to sections of the Internal Revenue Code shall be considered references to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as from time amended, and to the corresponding provisions of any similar law subsequently enacted.
