

Multiple Ownership Exhibit

Sarkes Tarzian, Inc. (“STI”) hereby demonstrates that grant of the instant application will be fully consistent with the Commission’s local radio multiple ownership rule. By this application, STI proposes to change the community of license of Station WTTS(FM), FCC Facility ID No. 59141, from Bloomington, Indiana, to Trafalgar, Indiana. Grant of the application will not create new or increased concentration of ownership among commonly owned, operated or controlled media properties.

WTTS(FM) is currently licensed to Bloomington, Indiana, which is located in Monroe County, Indiana. Monroe County is located outside of any Nielsen Audio market; however, WTTS has been listed as “home” to the Indianapolis, Indiana radio market as defined by Nielsen Audio. By this application, STI proposes to change WTTS’s community of license from Bloomington, Indiana, to Trafalgar, Indiana, which is located in Johnson County, Indiana. Johnson County is located in the Indianapolis, Indiana radio market as defined by Nielsen Audio. No changes to the technical facilities of WTTS(FM) are proposed.

STI is also the licensee of Station WGCL(AM), FCC Facility ID No. 59131, Bloomington, Indiana. The principal community contours of stations WTTS and WGCL do overlap. The Commission’s local radio multiple ownership rule is not implicated by the common ownership of one AM station and one FM station; accordingly, a grant of this application is fully consistent with the local radio ownership rule.
