COMPLIANCE WITH 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.315


Baker Broadcasting, LLC, permittee of new station KKBK(FM), Channel 235B1, Baker, California, FCC File No. BPH-19971107MS, Facility ID No. 89128, is proposing to change the location of its authorized transmitter site. The new site is 75.6 meters southeast of the authorized site at Turquoise Mountain, San Bernardino County, California.

Exhibit 22A is a map depicting the KKBK(FM) proposed 70 dB μ F(50,50) city grade service contour. The map shows also the center of Baker. Baker is an unincorporated community so formal community boundaries do not exist. However, the city grade contour encompasses all of the area generally referred to as Baker, California. The contour was computed using the techniques described in detail in exhibit 28.

Therefore, the proposed facility satisfies the requirements of § 73.315(a).


