Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Hieb:

This letter concerns the request you filed on July 1, 2013, on behalf of Phasor Physics, Inc. ("Phasor"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K252EH to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that Phasor stated that Station K252EH went silent on October 11, 2012, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on January 24, 2013, and expired on July 23, 2013. Phasor requests extension of its STA due to continued technical problems. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Phasor's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K252EH to remain silent until October 11, 2013. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K252EH will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., October 12, 2013.¹** See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
