

ENGINEERING STATEMENT (Supplement)

The Commission's CDBS now shows that the dismissed applications for WNYZ-LP, New York, NY proposing channel 49 no longer require consideration as they have been removed from the database. As a result, a new OET study has been run and it has been determined that it is only necessary to reduce the presently authorized ERP of 1.8 kW down to 1.7 kW rather than the 1.6 kW that had been proposed in the original modification in order to satisfy requirements of not increasing interference to any pertinent authorizations or applications.

Attached Exhibits E-1 through E-5 are OET-69 reports that fully study the amended WBQM-LD proposal. Exhibit E-1 is a quick summary showing interference values from the OET studies comparing the present CP and the proposed modification. Likewise, Exhibits E-2 and E-3 show the present CP and proposed modification in the OET "summary studies" and Exhibits E-4 and E-5 are the "full" OET reports.

In summary, it is stated that in all scenarios depicted by the reports, there would be no increase of interference to any relevant station or application.
