Dear Mr. Stonebraker:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 5, 2020. Calvary requests an extension of the STA granted on December 10, 2019, to continue operating periodically with reduced power to protect construction workers while Honolulu Transit (HT) constructs a light rail line directly adjacent to the KHKA/KHLT tower site.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, Calvary stated that the nearby portion of the rail project is estimated to be completed sometime in 2022 (although we note that the entire project is slated to be completed later per the HT web page <https://www.honolulutransit.org/>).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Calvary may continue to operate periodically with reduced power as necessary to protect workers. Calvary must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

<sup>1</sup> KLHT(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1040 kHz with 10 kW (day and night) and shares the tower with KHKA.

Calvary must submit an e-mail to note the date the station resumed licensed operations per BL-20190723ABG with negligible changes.

This authority expires on **December 18, 2020**.
