Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to: 1) the request for special temporary authority ("STA") filed February 19, 2010, on behalf of Connecticut Public Broadcasting, Inc. ("CPB"); and 2) the Media Bureau's January 25, 2010, *Order* in MM Docket No. 99-325 ("*Order*"), which became effective on May 10, 2010. The *Order* provides for the issue of authorizations which run concurrently with the main station license, as opposed to STAs, which carry an expiration date.

Accordingly, the authority granted to Station WNPR on February 26, 2010, IS HEREBY MODIFIED to remove the expiration date. Station WNPR may operate with increased digital ERP, as follows:

Analog ERP 5.1 kW (H&V)
Digital ERP 0.51 kW (H&V)

Transmitter Power Output ("TPO") shall be maintained within 90% and 105% of the following¹:

Analog TPO: 0.86 kW
Digital TPO: 0.086 kW
Combined TPO: 0.946 kW

CPB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines; *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. It may be necessary to reduce the power of the digital signal or cease hybrid operation if interference complaints are received. Pursuant to 47 CFR Section 73.1635(b), this authority may

be modified or cancelled by the Commission without notice or right to hearing. This authority attaches to, and runs concurrently with, the main station license. CPB must post a copy of this authority with the station license.
