


**Engineering Statement**

This application requests permission to add nighttime service to the current daytime-only facility of WDMP (810 KHz) AM station at Dodgeville, Wisconsin. No physical construction is required, as the same tower used nondirectional with 250 watts daytime will be used at night with 10 watts. The proposed nighttime facility will not cause or increase objectionable nighttime interference, and is in compliance with all current FCC rules and policies.

**Radio Frequency Radiation Exposure Statement**

The tower is protected by a secure fence with a locked gate. The distance from the tower to the fence is greater than required by the FCC OST-65 bulletin for 0.25 KW at  $\frac{1}{4}$  wavelength. There is no RF radiation exposure hazard to the general public. When workers must enter the fenced area, climb the tower or otherwise place themselves into a situation which could result in overexposure, the station will either reduce power or cease transmitting entirely to protect the workers as necessary. The only access to the tower and immediate area is through the locked gate, controlled by the permittee.
