Dear Mr. Hare:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 4, 2019. PRI requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 8, 2017, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to complete ground system and transmission line repairs.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, we note that additional time is needed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and PRI may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and reduced power while maintaining daytime monitor points within licensed limits. PRI must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. PRI must submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations per BZ-20010803AAY with negligible



changes, or to note the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed (to update all operating parameters).

This authority expires on **July 6, 2020**.
