SUBJECT: Board of Regents Action on UHH

At its meeting on July 20, the Board accepted the following recommendation from the Committee on Academic Affairs and the Committee on Community Colleges:

That the Board accept the concept of the separation of Hawaii Community College from the University of Hawaii at Hilo and direct the President to form a steering committee to develop a plan of implementation to be presented to the Board at its meeting in November 1990.

This motion, offered by Regent Stephenson, followed upon an unsuccessful one made by Regent Takeyama and seconded by Regent Ushijima to separate HCC from the rest of UHH. The stimulus to the motion was President Simone's report and recommendation to the Committees that HCC be separated from UHH. Copies of the President's report are in the Deans/Provost office, Library and Division Offices.

I need to add that CAS' David Miller made a very strong plea that any action be postponed until the people of UHH and HCC could speak at a meeting in Hilo.

I will report to you in further detail as additional information becomes available.
