Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of Educational Media Foundation (“EMF”) (FRN 0004121000), licensee of the above-referenced station, pursuant to the Audio Division guidance issued on January 11, 2022, and January 25, 2022, we respectfully request special temporary authority for the station to operate at reduced power.

The station began suffering low power operations on February 2, 2022, as a result of transmitter failure. EMF is working to return the station to full power operations, but has run into some delays and needs some additional time to complete the repairs. EMF respectfully requests special temporary authority to operate the station at reduced power until such time as the necessary work can be completed. EMF will promptly notify the Commission when the station resumes licensed operations.

Undersigned counsel has been authorized by EMF to state that neither EMF nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
