TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), licensee of radio station WHHY-FM, Channel 270C0, Montgomery, Alabama. It has come to Cumulus's attention that the coordinates of the WHHY-FM license are at variance with the Antenna Structure Registration Number 1042484 (converted to NAD 1927). Cumulus herein proposes to correct the coordinates of the transmitter site to bring them into accord with the ASR. The coordinates of the WHHY-FM license are North Latitude 32° 24' 11", West Longitude 86° 11' 48" (NAD 1927). The actual coordinates of the site and ASR (when converted to NAD 1927) are North Latitude 32° 24' 13", West Longitude 86° 11' 47". Since the correction is only 2 seconds latitude and 1 second longitude, this instant application proposes to correct the coordinates. There are no spacing issues for WHHY-FM at the corrected site, as shown on Exhibit A. Therefore, this proposal is in compliance with §73.1690(c)(11) of the rules. A calculation of the transmitter power output of the WHHY-FM transmitter is attached as Exhibit B.

Since there is no construction permit, there are no conditions to be met. However, since WHHY-FM shares an antenna with WAFX, Prattville; WLWI-FM, Montgomery; and WMXS,

Montgomery, Alabama, Cumulus has taken measurements to demonstrate that WHHY-FM is operating in compliance with §73.317 of the rules. Attached as Exhibit C is a harmonic and spurious emissions report showing that the shared antenna, with all stations operating, is in compliance with §73.317 of the rules.

Cumulus herein states that it will also reduce the power of WHHY-FM or cease operation, as needed, to insure that persons with access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency radiation levels in excess of the Commission's guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that WHHY-FM is operating in compliance with the Commission's rules.
