
Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for a new low power FM station.

Pursuant to Section 17.4(a) of the Commission's Rules,¹ any proposed construction of a new antenna structure or proposed alteration of an existing antenna structure that requires notification to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires registration with the Commission prior to construction or alteration. On May 8, 2014, we sent a letter to the applicant indicating that failure to register the tower or provide an update about the status of the tower registration, within 20 days of that letter, would result in dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute. As of the date of this letter, the tower remains unregistered. Furthermore, we have not received a response to the May 8th letter. Accordingly, the application will be dismissed.

Therefore, in light of the above, application BNPL-20131115ARR is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1) and is HEREBY DISMISSED for failure to prosecute. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
