

Exhibit 14 - Salt Lake City-Ogden-Provo

This exhibit with attached maps demonstrates that the acquisition proposed in the instant application comports with the Commission's radio-television cross-ownership rule.

In this application, the assignee Bonneville Holding Company ("BHC") proposes, as a result of the instant transaction to hold the licenses of Stations KSFI(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah, KRSP-FM, Salt Lake City, Utah, KQMB(FM), Midvale, Utah and a construction permit to operate on 820 kHz, authorized under call sign KUTR(AM), Taylorsville, Utah.

The 1 mV/m contours of the above-referenced three FM stations and the 2 mV/m contour authorized in the construction permit for KUTR(AM) completely encompass the community of license of KSL(TV), Salt Lake City, Utah which is licensed to BHC. BHC also holds a license for KSL(AM), Salt Lake City, Utah. Section §73.3555(c) of the Commission's Rules provides that a party may own, operate, or control two commercial television stations and up to six commercial radio stations (to the extent permitted by the local radio multiple ownership rule), or one commercial television station and up to seven commercial radio stations (to the extent permitted by the local radio multiple ownership rule), in a market where at least 20 independently owned media voices would remain in the market after the proposed transaction. At least 20 independently owned media voices, as defined by Section 73.3555(c), would remain in the Salt Lake City-Ogden-Provo market after the proposed transaction. Thus, BHC can hold the licenses for KSFI(FM), KRSP-FM, KQMB(FM), KSL(AM), and the construction permit for KUTR(AM) and KSL-TV under the radio-television cross-ownership rule.
