**Existence of Applicant**

The applicant, a non-profit charitable, religious and educational organization, is a State of Washington non-profit corporation which was incorporated on May 10, 2007. The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, religious and educational in nature. Its headquarters is located at 2098 East Alder Street, Walla Walla, Washington, at approximate NAD27 coordinates 46° 04' 01" north latitude and 118° 17' 17" west longitude.

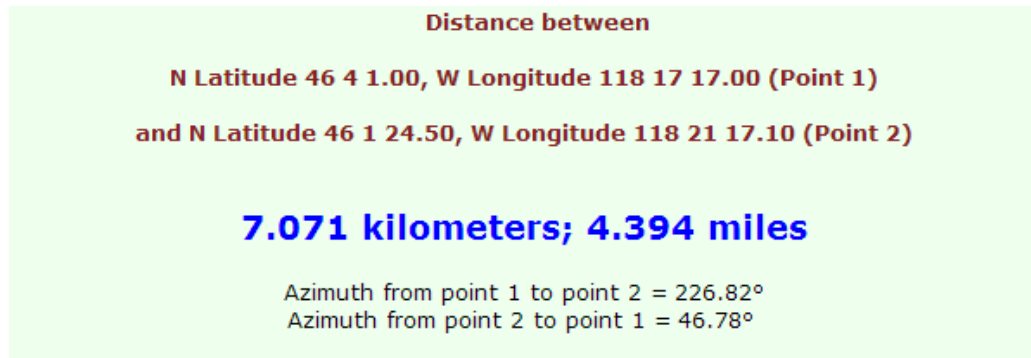

Our transmitter and antenna location is at NAD27 coordinates 46° 01' 24.5" north latitude and 118° 21' 17.1" west longitude. The distance between the applicant's headquarters and the proposed antenna site is 4.394 miles.

## Find Distance and Azimuths Between 2 Sets of Coordinates -- Results



As we understand Section 73.853 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations, since the applicant's headquarters are located within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location the applicant qualifies as a local non-profit educational organization. Additionally, ten of the eleven board members of the applicant have lived within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location for at least the last 24 months.

**Localism**

As noted above, our organization has been in existence in Walla Walla, Washington since 1953, and has been a corporate entity with a non-profit charter granted by the Washington Secretary of State since May 10, 2007; at all times since then it has been in existence within 20 miles of the proposed transmitter and antenna site.

Therefore, this application qualifies as an “established local applicant” pursuant to Section 73.853(b) of the FCC’s Rules.
