Dear Mr. O Laughlin:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 27, 2017. CRN requests an extension of the STA granted on November 17, 2014, to operate with temporary facilities to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application (due to loss of the licensed site).¹ In support of the request, CRN states that additional time will be needed to construct the new facility and then file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and CRN may continue to operate with the following facilities:



¹ KLIM(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1120 kHz with 0.25 kW daytime-only, and BMP-20170323AAO authorizes a new 50 kW DA daytime-only facility at a different site.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CRN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 3, 2018**.
