
Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application for W220DM, Parma, Ohio.

An engineering study of the application reveals that it is in violation of both 47 C.F.R. § 74.1235(d)(3) and the Working Arrangement for the Allotment and Assignment of FM Broadcasting Channels Under the Agreement Between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America in Relation to the FM Broadcasting Service ("Working Agreement"). Section 74.1235(d)(3) requires that within 320 kilometers of the common border, the maximum distance to the interfering contour (34 dBu) may not exceed 60 kilometers in the direction of the other country. The proposed facility is approximately 60 kilometers from the common border and the interfering contour exceeds 60 kilometers in the direction of Canada. Therefore, the application fails to comply with the US-Canadian Agreement and will be dismissed.

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20130417AAN IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
