Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for license to cover construction permit (BMPCDT-20080618ATO) for station KUVE-DT, Green Valley, AZ.

The staff's initial review of your application revealed that the constructed facility differs from the authorized facility. Specifically, the antenna model specified in the construction permit differs from the antenna model in the license application. The staff has requested an amendment but there has been no response. Thus, final processing of your application has been delayed.

It is not Commission policy, and we do not believe the public interest is served thereby, to allow a television station to operate on program test authority indefinitely. Therefore, you are directed to submit an amendment to your license application illustrating that there is no difference between the antenna patterns referenced in the construction permit and license applications. Your failure to provide the appropriate amendment within 30 days from the date of this letter may result in the dismissal of your pending license application. If the latter action is necessary, you will no longer have authority to operate station KUVE-DT and you will be required to cease operations. Hopefully, this action can be avoided by your prompt response to our request.
