Dear Mr. Benedict:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned application to change the transmitter site and the directional pattern for station KXNT(AM) ; our March 5, 2009, letter granting additional time to resolve the nighttime interference problem with Mexican station XENVA2; and the June 3, 2009, amendment in which CBS claims the licensed and proposed nighttime RSS contributions do not enter 50% RSS nighttime calculations for station XENVA2.

A preliminary review of the application as amended reveals that CBS cannot use objected Mexican records or US/Canadian dummy records as valid RSS contributors to show protection to station XENVA2, and our records indicate that the Mexican government has previously objected to the currently licensed KXNT facilities. Accordingly, CBS must now either file a curative amendment to eliminate the RSS problem with XENVA2 as previously requested, or file an amendment requesting the Commission's Audio Division staff to withhold further action on the application until after the FCC's International Bureau (IB) staff has entered into negotiations with the Mexican government to determine if any other course of action can be taken to resolve this problem. All questions concerning this issue or other foreign records should be directed to the FCC's IB staff.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to file an amendment. Failure to amend within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
