Request for Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

This letter concerns the request you filed on September 10, 2014, on behalf of Sun Valley Radio, Inc. ("Sun Valley"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit Station K250AV to remain silent.

Sun Valley's request states that Station K250AV will experience radio frequency interference to the input signal of another pre-existing translator station. Sun Valley's certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

On September 3, 2014, on behalf of Sun Valley Radio, Inc., you requested to permit FM Translator Radio Station K250AV to

Sun Valley's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K250AV to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broad conditions of the license will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations resume on or after August 21, 2015.**² See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Station K250AV to remain silent on August 20, 2014, due to claims of interference to the input signal of another pre-existing translator station. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

The station's silent status does not suspend the license conditions of the license, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed maintenance and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained in accordance with 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.61 and 17.62.

Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K250AV to remain silent on August 20, 2014, due to claims of interference to the input signal of another pre-existing translator station. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹ **Notwithstanding the date of this letter, notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W243CR will not commence by 12:01 a.m., September 1, 2014.** See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

Station K250AV to remain silent on August 20, 2014, due to claims of interference to the input signal of another pre-existing translator station. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹ **Notwithstanding the date of this letter, notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W243CR will not commence by 12:01 a.m., September 1, 2014.** See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).
