RE: New proposed FM station for Estes Park, Colorado

Dear Mr. Michael,

Rocky Mountain Public Broadcasting Network, Inc., licensee of KRMA-TV, Channel 6, Denver, Colorado, hereby states that it has no objections to the construction and operation of a proposed new non-commercial FM station in Estes Park, CO to be operated by Cedar Cove Broadcasting, Inc ("CCB"), on 90.7 mhz (channel 214A). The proposed new station will operate from Prospect Mountain at the coordinates of N 40-21-38, W 105-31-12, with no more than 200 watts Effective Radiated Power and a directional antenna system.

By signing this letter below, CCB agrees that, if interference to Channel 6 should arise as a result of the proposed new FM station operation, CCB will immediately cease operation of the station until a solution to the interference can be found. Rocky Mountain Public Broadcasting Network, Inc. will be the sole judge of whether interference is occurring to Channel 6 as a result of the proposed FM station.

CCB will also supply TVI filters at no cost to listeners whose reception of the Channel 6 signal may be adversely affected by the proposed FM station.
